
## Form for "Cautions"



The Wehrmacht took disciplinary measures against soldiers who had misbehaved. The caution form pictured here represented the final step in the proceedings before the soldiers were handed over to the police, which often meant imprisonment in a concentration camp. Between 1938 and 1945, around 800 soldiers were convicted of "sabotaging military service" and imprisoned in concentration camps. Many of them were men who had shown deviations in social behaviour, like "criminals", homosexuals and pacifists.

Decree ordering the expulsion from the Wehrmacht of military prisoner M. and his subsequent handing over to the police. This decree was issued by the 32nd Infantry Division by request of Field Penal Camp I on 20 June 1943. The sailor M. had been sentenced to two years and three months in prison and subsequent detention in a penal camp for "activities undermining the armed forces" consisting of "unauthorised leave", the falsification of documents and theft.
