Additionally, the bill requires military registration or military training to be a state servant.

A leader of presidential faction Arakhamia said that <u>arrest of bank accounts is unacceptable</u> and promised "work" on it, but I think that even with small changes main problems will arise from enforcement of the law. In practice some technicalities such as demand to renew military registration data during 60 days via military recruitment offices or administrative service centers, more simplified summoning to recruitment centers even without new draconian measures of influence (though I am not sure they will be removed significantly) could entail changes in application of existing administrative and criminal penalties, worsen it, because of introduction of simplified procedures helping to allege "evasion" and because of symbolic significance of tightening the belts.

The bill 10449 passed in the first reading includes

- basic military training for all men in age up to 25
- mandatory military registration, more easy summoning (including via email), more powers of military recruiters in cooperation with police
- measures of influence on those who avoids military registration, including prohibition to travel abroad, suspension of driver's license and freezing of bank accounts by decision of court
- no provisions for conscientious objectors (who basically should not be subjects to military registration, because it is a form of military duty)

Dmytro Lubinets, parliamentary commissioner for human rights, <u>criticized the bill for violation of constitutional rights</u> (inter alia, for no provisions regarding alternative service) but after a meeting with the minister of defense <u>called to adopt the bill in first reading</u>. Pressure from the military is enormous.
